Sarah Mali is the Director General of the Jewish Federations Canada-UIA in Israel. She most recently held the role of Vice President of Masa Israel Journey.

Sarah has served the Jewish community for over two decades and led impactful change processes in Canada, Israel and around the world. She is a prolific writer and public speaker. In 2022, Sarah was named one of "50 of Our Favorite Women Right Now" by Future of Jewish.

In her role as Director General of JFC-UIA, Sarah has worked to advance Israeli emergency philanthropy following the horrific events of October 7th. Within this context, Sarah was recently hailed by Ynet as one of the three most influential women who stand at the forefront of aid to Israel. Sarah has travelled the length of Israel to support all Canadian partnership regions from Metulla to Be'er Sheva and Sderot, ensuring that their leaders and communities are supported and to hear their evolving needs.

Sarah holds degrees from the London School of Economics and Hebrew University and is a graduate of the Harvard Kennedy School of Government, with a specialization in Adaptive Leadership. She is a trained organizational consultant with certification from the Israel-based Tavistock Institute.
